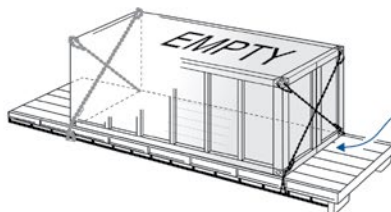

## VEHICLES WITHOUT TWIST LOCKS MUST –

**Place the empty container on timber gluts/dunnage, rubber mats or friction matting**  
**Less than 4 twist locks? Chains must also be used to secure your load**

1. Cross chain the container as per the diagram

**OR**

2. Chain the empty container over each end using a minimum of 8mm chain and tensioning with turnbuckles or dogs on both sides



**3. The above direction is as per the National Transport Commissions Load Restraint Guide**

A complying Container Weight Declaration (CWD) is required when transporting a consigned freight container on a road using a heavy vehicle. The requirement for a complying CWD is not dependent on whether the freight container is empty or loaded.

A complying container weight declaration is not required for a freight container that has been modified so it is no longer fit for use in multi-modal transport, or its primary use would no longer be for the transport of freight (e.g., modified for use as a storage shed, portable office, portable plant equipment, etc.).
